POSITION: Organist - Choir Accompanist

CLASSIFICATION: Regular, Part-time, Musician

REPORTS TO: Senior Pastor

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1) Grace-oriented, Spirit-filled commitment to Jesus Christ and his church.
- 2) Musically proficient and comfortable with a wide variety of musical styles.
- 3) Organized, flexible and collegial when working in collaboration with others.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1) Play organ and lead congregational song at the 8:30am Heritage Service on Sunday mornings.
- 2) Share piano playing duties with other music ministers at the Heritage service on Sunday mornings.
- 3) Accompany the Chancel Choir during Wednesday evening rehearsals and on Sunday mornings when the Choir performs in worship. (September-May only)
- 4) Participate and collaborate with other musicians in blended worship at all three services on Reformation Sunday, Ascension Sunday and other special occasions.
- 5) Play organ and piano at holiday services, including but not limited to:
 - Thanksgiving Eve
 - 10:00pm Heritage Candlelight service on Christmas Eve
 - Maundy Thursday
 - Good Friday
 - 7:00am Sunrise and 8:30am Heritage services on Easter Sunday.

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1) Participate in monthly worship planning meetings. (Evenings and weekends only.)
- 2) Communicate with staff and volunteer musicians regarding rehearsal and performance schedules.
- 3) Provide the Office Manager with titles and copyright information in a timely manner for inclusion in the bulletin.
- 4) Play for funerals and weddings as available.
- 5) Recruit and arrange for guest soloists to perform Heritage service preludes as possible.
- 6) Receive training in and demonstrate a commitment to following PLC's Protect Our Children policy.
- 7) Participate in general congregation-wide events in order to build relationships with and engender support for our Heritage music program from those who attend other services.
